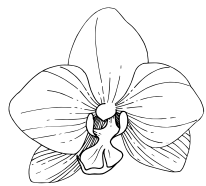

Thank you everyone.

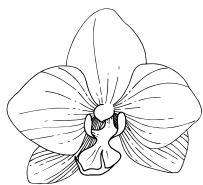

To be fair, we would be grateful if you could please refrain from:

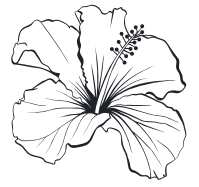
- Reserving seats;

The Safety Bay Retreat Centre is a ministry of the Sisters of St John of God. Set in tranquil grounds close to the ocean, the Centre serves as a hospitable space for many different groups of people seeking retreat, rest or formation. This peaceful haven was initially established as a holiday home for the Sisters in 1958, when it was blessed and opened by Archbishop Prendiville. It has become a sacred place for the Sisters and holds a strong emotional and spiritual attachment for them. Some of the Sisters' most treasured memories are associated with "The Bay".

- Wi-Fi access

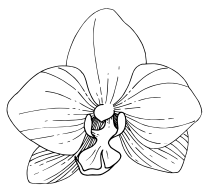
